Mayor Joyner reported that a kick-off meeting had been held in October @ 30% design phase with the engineers and contractors. He stated that the next meeting would be held on November 19 @ 60% design phase, and that Walker Industries was in the process of putting together a groundbreaking ceremony for the new plant.

NUCOR:

Mayor Joyner also updated that Johnny Jacobs with NUCOR will be attending next months meeting for an update on construction and to possibly plan a tour of the plant site with the Council.

DEPARTMENTAL REPORTS:

The monthly office report was submitted by Amy Haynes, City Clerk.

The monthly police department and Citizens on Patrol report was presented by Chief Haag.

The monthly Wa/Sw report was presented by T.J. Hughes, Public Works Director.

PLANNING & ZONING – Board of Adjustments:

Mayor Joyner updated that the Board of Adjustments had met earlier in the day with 3 requests being presented for conditional use regarding temporary RV parks in the City limits. He stated that all 3 requests were approved for a term of 30 months. If at the end of the term the owner would like to extend the park usage, an additional hearing would be held to determine if there was a need to do so.

Mayor Joyner also stated that Bobby Skaggs had submitted his resignation effective 11/01/2020 from the Planning and Zoning Commission, and stated that there were now 2 vacancies to fill on the board, and he would welcome any suggestions for individuals interested in serving.

OTHER BUSINESS:

One-time salary adjustments were discussed among the Council/Mayor. A motion was made by Bill Basham, seconded by Charlotte Ford, to raise the adjustment to \$700.00 for the current year. Vote of motion was unanimous by Council.
