

CAMPGROUND RULES / REGULATIONS

Dates of Operation:

The Campground will be open yearly from April 1st through November 30th. All utilities will be shut off on December 1st.

No Alcoholic Beverages:

KRS 222.202 (2) A person is guilty of drinking alcoholic beverages in a public place when he drinks alcoholic beverages in a public place. A peace officer shall make an arrest for a violation of KRS 222.202

Fires:

Cooking fires are permitted in park grills, or suitable private grills, or in campground fire pits, and should be attended at all times. During periods of extreme fire danger (these times will be posted) fires of any type may be prohibited.

Pets: All campers shall clean up after their pets.

A pet shall:

- 1. Be kept on a leash or otherwise restrained.
- 2. Have current inoculations for rabies.

Sewage / Gray Water:

Sewage or gray water from recreational vehicles shall not be disposed of on the premises of the campground except at provided sewage disposal site.

Water:

Water hookups are provided for each campsite to be used for camping only. Campers/RV's, or any type of vehicle shall not be washed using this water source. **Regulators are recommended due to water pressure in park of over 80 psi**

Vehicles:

All personal/tow vehicles shall be parked in assigned campsite or public parking lot, no vehicles shall be parked in the grass. No more than 2 vehicles shall be permitted per campsite.

Four wheelers, all-terrain vehicles, or any type of utility vehicle are prohibited in the campground and entire Riverfront Park.

Golf carts may be utilized by campers, but the carts must remain in the campground area, and must be operated by an individual of at least 16 years of age.

Reservations/Campsite Regulations:

- *Reservations cannot be made for tent camping only. There may be a tent only if there is an RV reservation with the RV on the site.
- *Campsites are reserved on a first come / first serve basis through the Brandenburg City Hall office (270)422-4981, 8:00am-4:30 pm Monday thru Friday and afterhours (270) 422-3774 or on the City's website www.brandenburg.ky.gov. The fee per night is \$25.00. Should a camper wish to set up at a time when the office is closed, they can do so on empty camping spots which do not have a reservation tag, and make payment during regular business hours or online.
- *Cancellations must be made within 24 hours from date of arrival for a full refund
- *Campground check-in time is 2:00pm / check- out time is 12:00 Noon
- *Only 1 camper/RV shall be allowed per campsite with a limit of 6 persons per campsite.
- *There shall be a ten (10) day maximum stay in the campground per calendar month, with a minimum of 10 days between visits.
- *All campers shall keep their camp site clean, and dispense of all trash in provided dumpsters upon leaving.
- *Fireworks are **never** allowed in the campground.
- *Campers shall not deface or damage park property.
- *Picnic tables and/or Fire rings shall not be removed from campsite.
- *Quiet time in the campground shall begin at 10:00pm and remain in effect until 7:00am the following morning.
- *Any maintenance issues in the campground shall be reported to Brandenburg City Hall, Monday thru Friday, @ 270-422-4981, or after-hours @ 270-422-3774.
- * If the police are called to your campsite for any type of disturbance you may be evicted without refund.
- *Failure to comply with any campground rules / regulations may result in eviction from the campground by City of Brandenburg administrators or police. Repeat offenders will not be allowed to return.

**Weather Emergencies: The immediate shelter will be the bathhouse located at the campground. **
